### 2010 - 11 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

In an effort to promote the integrity of federal, institutional, and state financial assistance programs and ensure equitable distribution of available funds, it is the policy of New England College Student Financial Services Office to verify the information provided by selected applicants for financial assistance, including applications for federal educational loans. We encourage you to use figures from a completed 2009 Federal Income Tax Return when completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). If your tax return is not completed in time to submit the FAFSA by our established priority filing deadline, you are urged to estimate the information requested on the form to the best of your knowledge.

In order for the student applicant to receive full consideration for scholarships, grants, loans and/or Federal Work Study, the FAFSA (or FAFSA Renewal Application) must be fully processed and received by the Student Financial Services Office at New England College along with supporting documentation. For fastest FAFSA processing, please complete the form online at <a href="https://www.fafsa.ed.gov">www.fafsa.ed.gov</a>. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that his/her completed financial aid application materials are received and processed by NEC Student Financial Services by the priority deadline. Financial assistance notification letters will be mailed one to two weeks from the time we receive all materials. If you do not submit all forms by the stated priority deadline, you are still eligible to apply for financial aid on a funds-available basis.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION/REQUIREMENTS

**State Scholarships**.— All applicants should apply on time for their respective state scholarships if their legal state of residence has a reciprocating agreement to receive scholarship funds if attending a private college in New Hampshire. Applicants applying for a state scholarship or grant are asked to contact their home state scholarship program for specific application procedures, eligibility guidelines and deadlines. New England College will not award institutional need-based grant funding to replace lost state scholarship funds if you fail to meet your home state's application requirements.

**Federal Student Loan Program** – Federal Student Loan eligibility is determined by demonstrated financial need. All student loan applicants for Subsidized or Unsubsidized Stafford Loans must have a complete financial assistance application on file as described in this form, prior to the determination of loan eligibility. The Master Promissory Note and Entrance Interview for Stafford Loans will be available online for all first time borrowers at New England College.

**Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)** – Federal regulations require a student to be making satisfactory academic progress in order to receive financial assistance. Satisfactory academic progress policies are outlined in the *New England College Undergraduate Catalogue*.

**Status Changes** – Changes in enrollment or housing status may affect your financial assistance. You must notify the Office of Student Financial Services if your situation changes. Financial assistance for juniors and seniors is dependent on the number of credits needed to graduate. Once degree requirements are met, financial assistance may be changed accordingly.
