## Pilgrim Hoop Camp

Embracing a holistic philosophy, Hoop Camp provides a learning environment in which each and every player develops new skills and confidence. We believe that the best way to learn the game of basketball is through playing. Our schedule includes group and individual skill sessions as well as team competitions.

### Camp Design

This camp is tailored to beginning, intermediate, and experienced basketball players ages 7-17. Campers must arrive at Hoop Camp committed to learning as much about basketball as they can, working as hard as they can, and striving for excellence both on and off the court. Campers will be taught proper technique, strategy, and fitness throughout the week; **OUR COACHING STAFF WILL TEACH THE GAME OF BASKETBALL BY EXAMPLE AND STRESS SPORTSMANSHIP, ENTHUSIASM, AND FUN.**

### Safety

A certified athletic trainer will be present at the camp at all times. Expenses resulting from illness, injury, or accidents are the responsibility of the camper's parents/guardians.

### Lunch

There will be a 45-minute break for lunch. **Campers will need to provide their own lunch.** Water will be issued throughout the day; campers should provide their own water bottles.

**From Concord:** 89N to exit 5, 202/9W to Henniker, New England College exit, left off the exit follow 114 through blinking light and follow signs to Bridges Gym.

**From Keene:** 9E to New England College exit, right off exit follow 114 through blinking light and follow signs to Bridges Gym.

**From New London:** 89S to exit 6, right off exit onto rt. 127, follow 127 take a right onto 202/9W to Henniker New England College exit, left off the exit follow 114 through blinking light and follow signs to Bridges Gym.

**Player Evaluation** – Upon arrival, players are evaluated and grouped with others of similar age, size, and skill level. A summary of skill level and achievement is provided to each camper at the end of the week. This written evaluation suggests skills and drills for the player to work on at home and at school.

**Daily Competition** – All players will play two games each day. Each player participates in an equal amount of time ensuring that everyone is given opportunities to put into play those skills he/she has been honing during the drills and skills sessions.

**Individual Attention**...is our trademark. Our coaching staff takes a personal interest in each player's progress. The instructional program is intense and comprehensive; we will give each camper the support that he/she needs to improve throughout the week.

### **Charlie Mason, Head Coach of the New England College Pilgrims**

Charlie Mason is currently in his sixth season as head coach of the Pilgrims. Over the past five seasons Mason has compiled a record including a trip to the CCC Tournament in 2005.

Intent on providing student athletes a well rounded collegiate experience, Coach Mason emphasizes a strong commitment to both the personal growth and academic achievement of the program's student athletes. Under Mason's direction, the NEC Men's Basketball team has participated annually in such community projects as Readers as Role Models, Special Olympics and Junior Gym Grims. Prior to New England College, Mason served as the Head Men's Basketball Coach and Assistant Athletic Director at Johnson State. In his seven years, Johnson State was annually ranked among the elite teams of the Mayflower Conference. Mason's efforts were recognized by his peers in 2000 when he was named Mayflower Coach of the Year.

Charlie Mason earned his MA in education at Rockford College in 1994. He earned his BA in History from Concordia University in 1991 and a BS in Human Movement from Johnson State in 1997. He was a four-year letter winner at Concordia University and a member of its 1990 national championship team. Mason was inducted into the Concordia University Hall of Fame in 1998.
