Apply for Financial Aid starting October 1

U.S. citizens or permanent residents: Apply for financial aid online through the Free Application for Financial Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.ed.gov. Select the 2020-2021 FAFSA and add New England College's Federal Code (002579). Student Financial Services counselors can assist you with any questions about financial aid or completing the FAFSA. International students or non-U.S. citizens: Submit the CSS profile at cssprofile.collegeboard.org/ to see if you are eligible for any need-based financial aid. NEC's CSS code is 3657.
