Purpose: Support the Center Woods Elementary School, which serves over 700 students Pre-School through Grade 5.

Motivation/Interests Required: Center Woods Elementary School in Weare invites work study students to sharpen their skills working with younger children, either as a classroom assistant, a one-on-one tutor, or a reading buddy. Students may correct homework, help with educational games, or other classroom activities.

Students should be excited about working in an educational context; this is a great chance to gain hands-on experience and skills while working with a classroom teacher.

Position Description:

- Support children in classrooms, on the playground and in the lunchroom through active participation.
- In the classroom setting, assist the child in completing a given task, listen to a child read or read to a student, help with preparation of materials.
- Provide adult supervision to a small group.
- At recess or in the lunchroom, the student would help with development of social skills through organizing play and modeling appropriate lunch table manners and conversation.
- School bus supervisor, 2 hours a day in the afternoon
- Maintenance

Supervision: NEC students will be supervised by a classroom teacher

Benefits to Student:

- Gain skills in teaching and in understanding the learning process.
- Gain familiarity with public elementary school structure and procedures.
- Gain skills in communicating with professional teachers on the subjects of teaching and learning.
