For elementary students :

- 5 week Sept-Oct and again 4 -5 weeks in Oct Nov: Fall Games, approx. 2:30 4:30 Wednesdays
- 5 week session Jan Feb and again 5 week session in March: Kidrobics, approx. 2:30 4:30 Wednesdays

For middle school students:

Program for 5th - 7th graders on Thursdays. These would be primarily recreational games- ping pong; basketball; volleyball; floor hockey; flag football etc. Sessions would run for 4-5 weeks in conjunction with the elementary weeks & last 1 hour for middle school.

Purpose: A work-study program for PE students to work in an after-school program teaching & directing physical activities for middle school and elementary students. Focus would be on running large group activities. Full-time teacher/supervisor will remain as the administrative contact person, getting the permission slips, assisting with discipline and ensuring that parents are present for students at the conclusion of the activity. *This work-study job may also be taken for credit through the Education Department, subject to approval of the faculty.*
