




Many Programs have an uninstaller located within the Program group itself – click “**Start**” “**All Programs**” and then check for the uninstall program in the folder for the program your trying to install. If not, follow the below instructions.


1. Go to “**Start**” “**Control Panel**”.



2. Double click “**Add and Remove Programs**”.





3. Locate the program you want to remove, in this case the example is Symantec Antivirus, click “Remove”



4. A *confirm uninstall* window will pop up.

Click “Yes”


Gathering info to uninstall program comes up.



5. Some Antivirus programs require a password to uninstall them. In this case, type in “Symantec” click “Ok”.



6. The program starts to uninstall.



7. Most programs will require you to restart your system, “**SAVE ANY FILES YOU MAY HAVE OPEN**”, click “Yes” to restart your system. When system restarts your program will be uninstalled.
