## Licensure Reciprocity

The following states are members of the NASDTEC Interstate Agreement and have educator licensure reciprocity with the State of New Hampshire. The NASDTEC Agreement specifies that the "receiving" state will authorize the inbound certificate holder to legally teach in the receiving state, provided the license issued by the "sending" state is valid. Some states might ask for additional licensure requirements. Additional coursework or testing may be required.
