KEYNOTE SPEAKER STAFF SERGEANT RYAN PITTS

Staff Sgt. Ryan Pitts joined the Army in 2003. He served as a radio telephone operator for the 4th Battalion, 319th Field Artillery Regiment, and 173rd Airborne Brigade. With the 173rd, he deployed to Afghanistan twice—in 2005 and 2007. He departed the active-duty Army in 2009.

Pitts's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal with Valor, the Purple Heart, Meritorious Service Medal, the Army Commendation Medal with three bronze oak leaf clusters, the Army Achievement Medal, the Army Good Conduct Medal with bronze clasp and two loops, the National Defense Service Medal, the Afghanistan Campaign Medal with two campaign stars, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, the Non-Commissioned Officer Professional Development Ribbon, the Army Service Ribbon, the Overseas Service Ribbon with numeral 4 device, the NATO Medal, the Combat Action Badge, the Parachutists Badge, the Pathfinder Badge, the Presidential Unit Citation, and the Valorous Unit Award.

He currently resides in Nashua, New Hampshire, where he is in business development for the computer software industry.

FOUNDERS DAY HISTORY

New England College was founded in 1946 to serve the educational needs of the country's military men and women returning from World War II.

The celebration of Founders Day at NEC was instituted to honor the vision and leadership of the founding faculty, staff, administration, and students of the College, and is one of three major academic events during the year.
