## KEYNOTE SPEAKER MAJOR GENERAL DAVID MIKOLAITIES

Maj. Gen. David J. Mikolaities has served as The Adjutant General of New Hampshire since September 23, 2017, acting as the military chief of staff to the governor and commissioner of the New Hampshire Department of Military Affairs and Veterans Services. In this dual role, he oversees the strategic direction of the Army and Air National Guard and all facets of veterans services, including the Division of Veterans Services, Community Based Military Programs, and the State Veteran's Cemetery.



Commissioned through the United States Military Academy at West Point in 1987, Maj. Gen. Mikolaities began his career on active duty with the 4th Infantry Division (Mechanized) at Fort Carson, Colorado, before transitioning to the reserve component and later joining the New Hampshire Army National Guard in 2007. His assignments include commander of the 54th Troop Command and service with Special Operations Command Central. He deployed to Qatar and Iraq in 2003–2004 and to Afghanistan in 2009 and 2010 in support of combined joint special operations.

He holds degrees in mechanical engineering, strategic studies, and management. A native of Manchester, he now resides in Portsmouth with his family.
