

## Apply for Financial Aid

Apply for financial aid online through the Free Application for Financial Aid (FAFSA) at [fafsa.ed.gov](https://fafsa.ed.gov). Select the 2019-2020 FAFSA and add New England College's Federal Code (002579). Student Financial Services counselors can assist you with any questions about financial aid. ## Submit Your Deposit

The first step to becoming a student at New England College is to accept your scholarship and secure your place in the class by submitting your enrollment deposit of \$300 at [nec.edu/deposit](https://nec.edu/deposit)

## Sign in to the Pilgrim Enrollment Portal at [pilgrim.nec.edu/portal](https://pilgrim.nec.edu/portal)

Access your enrollment forms and view announcements as the start of the semester nears. Once we receive your deposit, you'll receive an email with directions about how to set up your account.

## Complete your Enrollment Forms (including housing and meal plan)

If you wish to live on campus, fill out the Housing and Meal plan form in the Enrollment Portal. Once that is submitted, you can complete the Roommate Survey and remaining enrollment forms. If not living on campus, complete all remaining enrollment forms.

## Log into your NEC accounts

Log into [MyNEC](#) (where you can view your class schedule and bill for the semester) and your NEC email account. You will receive an email with your login information.

## Review financial aid award & complete your financial aid requirements

If you're using federal loans to cover the cost of NEC, submit your Master Promissory Note and Entrance Loan Counseling at [studentloans.gov](https://studentloans.gov) as soon as you deposit so your loans will be included in your bill for the semester.

## Submit your Wellness forms via Medica

Submit health forms via Medica at [nec.medicatconnect.com](https://nec.medicatconnect.com) using the same login information as your NEC email. Athletes have additional health requirements; see [nec.edu/health-wellness](https://nec.edu/health-wellness) for more information

## Submit payment options by bill due date

Payment options are: payment of balance in full by cash, credit card or check; approval for private loan or federal Parent PLUS loan that covers remaining balance; or set up monthly payment plan and make the first payment. ## Submit your final high school transcript
