

New Student Enrollment Checklist

Sign in to the Pilgrim Enrollment Portal at pilgrim.nec.edu/portal

Access your enrollment forms and view announcements as the start of the semester nears. Once we receive your deposit, you'll receive an email with directions about how to set up your account.

Apply for Financial Aid (if you haven't already!)

Apply for financial aid online at fafsa.ed.gov. To speak or meet with a financial aid counselor, please contact us at 603.428.2226 or sfs@nec.edu. Any requested financial aid forms can be uploaded to nec.verifymyfafsa.com.

Complete your Enrollment Forms (including housing and meal plan)

If you wish to live on campus, fill out the Housing and Meal plan form in the Enrollment Portal (forms will be available by April). Once that is submitted, you can complete the Roommate Survey and the remaining enrollment forms. Housing assignments will be sent by August 1.

Log into your NEC accounts

Log into [MyNEC](#) (where you can view your class schedule and bill for the semester) and your NEC email account. You will receive an email with your login information.

Register for a Pilgrimage session (Summer Orientation)

Select the orientation date that works best for you (dates will be announced by May). At Pilgrimage, you will meet with faculty and academic advisors, solidify your course schedule, and begin to build friendships with your future NEC classmates!

Complete your financial aid requirements

If you're using federal loans to cover the cost of NEC, submit your Master Promissory Note and Entrance Loan Counseling at studentloans.gov prior to June 8 (or as soon as you deposit) so your loans will be included in your bill for the semester.

Submit your Wellness forms via Medicat

Once you log into your NEC email, submit forms via Medicat at nec.medicatconnect.com. Athletes have additional health requirements; see nec.edu/health-wellness for more information

Submit payment options by bill due date

Payment options are: payment of balance in full by cash, credit card or check; approval for private loan or federal Parent PLUS loan that covers remaining balance; or set up monthly payment plan. More information about payment options can be found at nec.edu/payment

Submit your final high school transcript

Request that your high school counselor send a copy of your transcript with graduation date to our office via mail or by email at admission@nec.edu by August 15.
