Now that you've been accepted, here are your next steps:

Apply for Financial Aid starting October 1

U.S. citizens or permanent residents: Apply for financial aid online through the Free Application for Financial Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.ed.gov. New England College's Federal Code is (002579). Student Financial Services (SFS) counselors can assist you with any questions about financial aid or completing the FAFSA. To speak or meet with a financial aid counselor, please contact SFS at 603.428.2226 or sfs@nec.edu.

International students or non-U.S. citizens: Submit the CSS profile at cssprofile.collegeboard.org to see if you are eligible for any need-based financial aid. NEC's CSS code is 3657.

Upload any requested financial aid forms or information to nec.verifymyfafsa.com

After submitting your FAFSA, you will receive either a financial aid award from the Student Financial Services office or a request for additional information. If you receive a request for additional information to complete your financial aid award, create your account at nec.verifymyfafsa.com to submit any financial aid forms requested by the Student Financial Services office.
