

TO REGISTER TO VOTE, YOU WILL NEED TO BE:

1. 18 years of age or older on election day
2. A United States Citizen
3. Domiciled in the town or ward you plan to vote (the term domicile means to have residence)

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING PROOF OF THE ABOVE TO REGISTER

- Identity can be proved with a photo ID (driver's license, passport/passcard, military ID, school ID are commonly used).
- Age can be proved using a driver's license or non-driver ID from any state, a birth certificate or passport/passcard.
- Citizenship can be proved using a birth certificate, US passport/passcard, or naturalization document.
- Domicile can be proved with many things including driver's license or car registration with local address, mail, rental agreement.

If you do not have proof, you will be able to fill out an affidavit *and still vote* without it. Please [click here](#) for more information as to what proof to bring.

Students who live on campus do not need to bring proof of domicile. The College has worked closely with the town of Henniker and have provided them with a certified list of each residential student's name and domicile address. Please bring proof of ID, they will honor your NEC ID.

REGISTER TO VOTE

There are two ways to **Register in NH**

1. Register at Town Hall by Wednesday, October 28, 2020.
2. Register at the polls on the day of the election.

The College encourages you to **register in advance** to streamline your election day experience. To register in advance, please go to the [Henniker Town Hall](#). Their hours are as follows:

- Monday – Friday (except Thursdays): 8 am to 4:30 pm
- Thursdays: 2 pm – 4 pm
- Wednesday October 28: 8 am – 4:30 pm with an additional hour from 7 pm – 8 pm.

You may register in advance up until October 28. After that, you will be able to register at the polls on the day of the election.

REGISTER TO VOTE IN ANOTHER STATE

- If you are interested in voting in your home state, other than in NH, go to NEC.Turbovote.org. Turbovote will walk you step by step through the process
- If you miss the deadline to vote in your home state, you can always register to vote in NH!

VOTE!

- In Person - The polls are open on November 3, 2020, from 7 am – 7 pm.

- Absentee – If you have concerns about voting due to COVID-19, you can vote absentee. If you want to do this, act fast!
 - Go to NEC.Turbovote.org and complete all of the steps. Turbovote will mail you your absentee form along with a pre-paid envelope for you
