

The move in process for both Henniker and Manchester campuses will take place over multiple days. All students must sign up for a 2-hour block of time to move in. Move in will start at 8:30 am and end at 4:30 pm each day. Students will only be permitted to move in on the day and at the time they are scheduled to move in. Only students will be permitted to enter the residence halls on move in days. There will be additional staff on hand to assist with larger items. Please limit the number of family member/friends on move in day to 2. Everyone who is on campus on move in day will be required to wear a mask and practice social distancing. Once a vehicle has been unloaded, it will be required to move so that other students can unload.

As students approach the Henniker campus, they will be directed to pull into the Simon Center lot to check in. Once students check in, they will be given instructions for what to do next.

As students approach the Manchester campus, proceed to French Hall to check in and receive further instructions for what to do next.

All students who arrive on move in day will be required to be tested before moving into their respective residence hall.

**Health Records:** if your health records are incomplete, **you will not be permitted to move into your assigned room** until you are cleared to do so by the Wellness Center. There will be no exceptions to this policy.

**Student Financial Services:** all students must satisfy their account with Student Financial Services prior to moving into their Fall 2020 room assignment. Any student who is not cleared to move in by SFS will need to meet with an SFS staff member prior to moving in.

**Covid-19 Testing:** all students must be tested prior to moving into their residence hall. Testing will be available on campus prior to moving into the residence halls.

### **Move-In Guidelines**

Masks are mandatory for EVERYONE who will be on campus during any move in period. We are requiring students to limit the number of people who come to campus with you for move in to 2 family members/friends. Only students will be able to enter the residence halls on move in day.

Once students arrive on campus, all guidelines in the Pilgrim Promise will be in effect including non-essential travel and staying overnight anywhere without prior permission, wearing a mask at all times other than when you are in your residence hall room or bathroom, and maintaining social distance.
