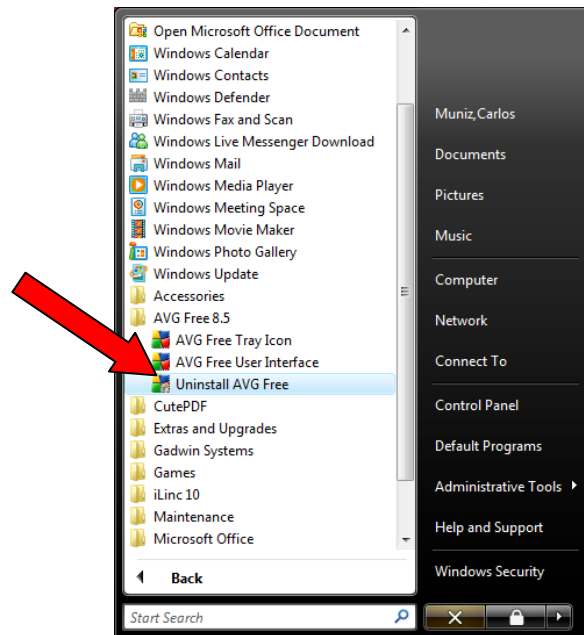
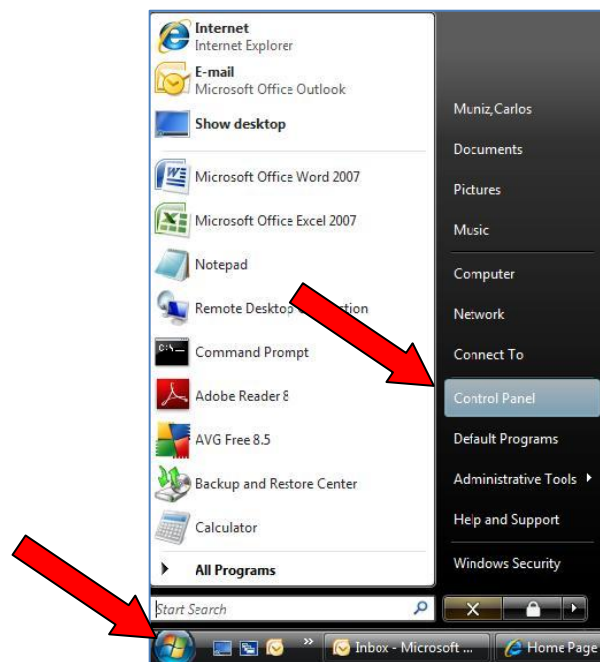

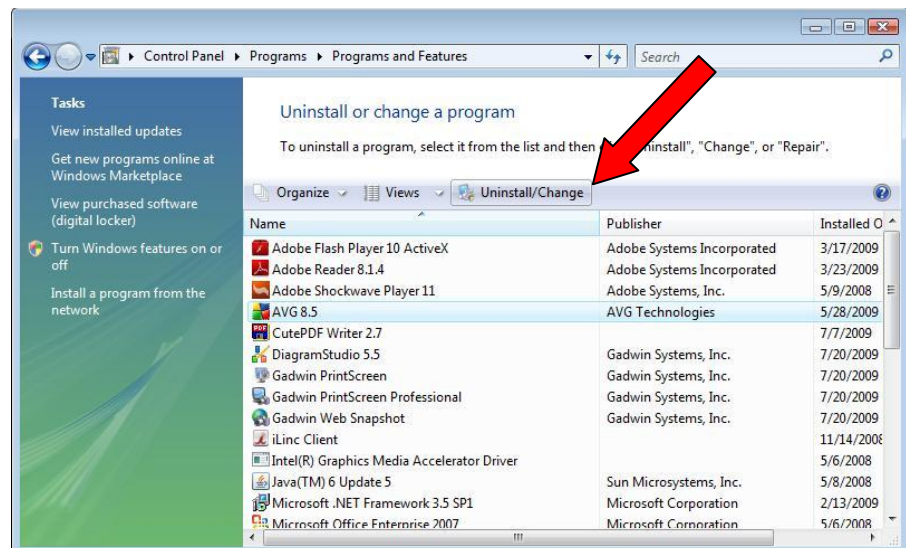


In some cases you will have to go to “Start”
“Control Panel”.

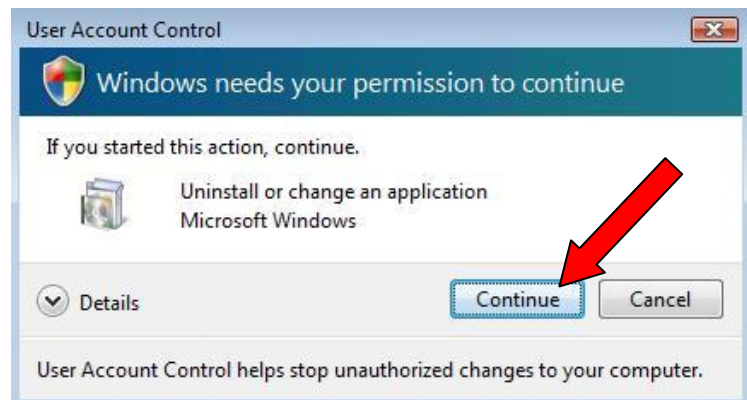




Select the program to remove then click “Uninstall/Change”.

Make sure that Remove user settings and Include objects in the Virus Vault are both checked and click “Yes”.

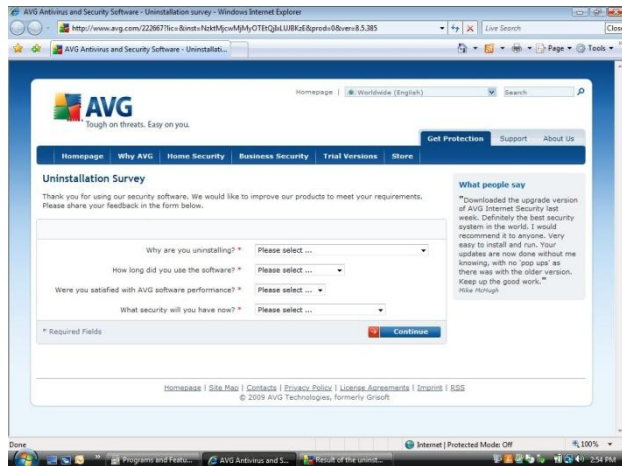
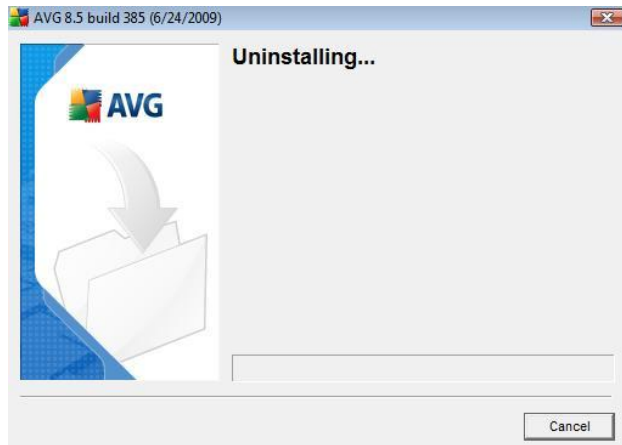




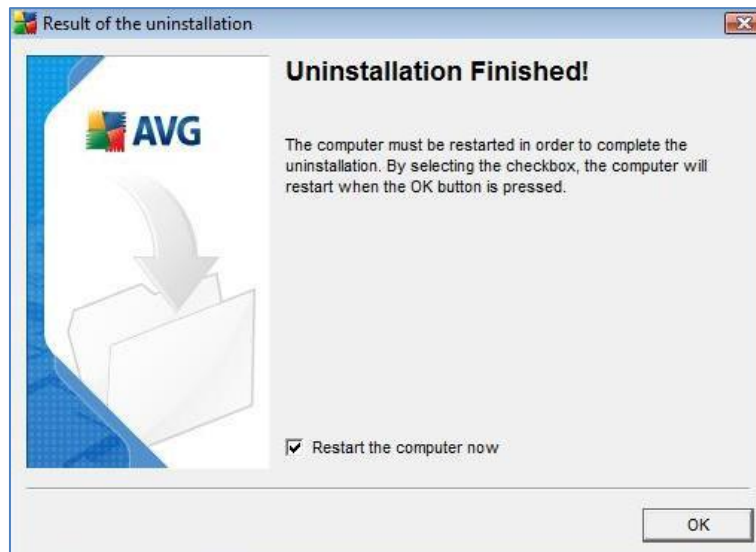
