Configuring Vipre Antivirus Software

- **First, ensure you do not have any other Antivirus installed.** See “Uninstalling Antivirus and other programs in Windows [Vista/7](#)” or “...XP” on our webpage www.nec.edu/helpdesk for assistance with this.
- You need a license key provided by NEC Information Technology. If you qualify you should receive this by email. If you have not, contact the NEC IT Help Desk by phone (603-428-2350) or [email](#). We will send the key only to your NEC email address to ensure you qualify for this free software.
- Download Vipre from <http://www.vipreantivirus.com/Antivirus-Trial/VIPRE-Antivirus/>


When you click the above links, you should receive a *File Download* warning similar to this one.

Click **Run**

Click **Continue**




On the Vipre installer Window Click **Next**

Ready to install the program


Click **Install**

Save and close any open documents


Click **Yes** to restart your system



Upon restart you should have a Vipre icon on desktop. Vipre will prompt you to register now or continue with a 30-day trial.


Click "**Register Now**" and enter the **25-character activation code** given to you by the Help Desk at the screen shown to the right.

Click **Next** and **Finish/Yes** when prompted



Right Click on Yellow Vipre icon and choose **Update Definitions Now**
